AVAILABILITY

Available to members of the District that are customers in towns re-aligned in 2001 by the Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) into the Northeast Nebraska PPD that have a current O&M lease agreement with Northeast. Available to farm commercial and residential uses subject to the District's established rules and regulations. This schedule is applicable to residences that share a joint electric service with some form of agricultural endeavor. This rate will also be applied to all single-phase services for which the District has on file a tax exemption form. Non-Farm residences may qualify for the Rural Residential rate. Service under this schedule is limited to maximum motor sizes as specified in District Policy 11-25, governing connection of large single phase motors.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycle, at available voltages.

RATE:

SUMMER - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of June-July-August-September

Monthly Customer Charge	\$22.85
All kWh's Distribution capacity charge	1.5 ¢ per kWh
All kWh's Wholesale power costs	8.38 ¢ per kWh
Total per kWh	9.88 ¢

WINTER - for energy (kWh's) used during the months of
January-February-March-April-May-October-November-December

Monthly Customer Charge	\$22.85
All kWh's Distribution capacity charge	1.5 ¢ per kWh
All kWh's Wholesale power costs	6.38 ¢ per kWh
Total per kWh	7.88 ¢

MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be the Customer Charge of \$22.85 where 25 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For consumers requiring more than 25 KVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of \$1.00 for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required.

ANNUAL CHARGES FOR SEASONAL SERVICES

Customers requiring service less than 500 kwh per year may request service according to Annual Single Phase with an annual minimum charge is due and payable in advance under the Annual Single Phase Rate. Any service disconnected and reconnected at the customer's request within a twelve month period by the customer will be charged a disconnect or reconnect fee for each trip to render service. The district stand-by service rider applies to this rate.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the date stated on the bill, then delinquent charges shall be added according to District Collection Policies.
